

## **COVID-19 COVID-19 AS2020 / 2021 CO-RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT**

**Parents / people exercising parental responsibilities / guardians**

aware of the criminal consequences forseen in case of false declarations,

**THEY SIGN THE FOLLOWING CO-RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT**

**for the pupil \_\_\_\_\_ enrolled at the Institute**

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### **a) ATTENDANCE IN THE SCHOOL INSTITUTE**

In particular, the parent (or holder of parental responsibility) declares:

- to be aware of the contagion containment measures in force as of today;
- that the child, or a cohabitant of the same within the family unit, is not subjected to the quarantine measure or that he/she has not tested positive for COVID-19;
- to undertake to keep their child at home in the presence of fever (equal to or greater than 37.5°), which must be measured daily before accessing school, or in the presence of other symptoms such as sore throat, nasal congestion, conjunctivitis, loss of smell or taste; to undertake to promptly inform the pediatrician of the display of symptoms;
- to be aware and accept that in case of fever equal to or higher than 37.5° or the presence of the other symptoms mentioned above, his / her child will not be admitted to school and will remain under his / her responsibility;
- to be aware and accept that, in case of fever (equal to or greater than 37.5°) or other symptoms (among those listed above), the school will keep the child or adolescent separate from others and will inform family members immediately;
- to be aware that his / her child must comply with the health and hygiene guidelines within the school;
- to have been adequately informed by the school of all the organizational and sanitary provisions for safety and for the containment of the risk of spreading of Covid-19;
- not to be allowed to access to school during activities and in the presence of the students, except for situations of proven emergency;
- to undertake to adopt behaviors of maximum precaution for the containment of covid-19 outbreak even outside the school;
- to be aware that during interaction activities, even if controlled, it is not possible to reduce the risk of contagion to zero, which instead must be reduced to a minimum through the scrupulous and rigorous observance of the precautionary and safety measures listed in specific protocols for carrying out activities, (for this reason it is important to use utmost caution even outside school).
- to self-monitor their health conditions, those of their child, family members and cohabitants, also by asking for the help of the General Practitioner and/or the pediatrician.

In particular, with reference to the "Protocol to ensure the start of the school year in compliance with the safety rules for containing the spread of Covid-19" issued by the Ministry of Education on 06.08.2020, pupils /students can attend school only if:

- they do not display respiratory symptoms or body temperature above 37.5 ° C even in the previous three days,
- they have not been in quarantine or home isolation in the past 14 days,
- they do not come from areas at risk as indicated by the WHO or other competent authorities,

- they have not been in contact with positive people, as far as you know, in the last 14 days.

Whenever his / her child or the parent himself or any of the family members and cohabitants show suspicious symptoms for COVID-19 (for example: fever, breathing problems, loss of taste and /or smell, sore throat, cough, nasal congestion, conjunctivitis, vomiting, diarrhea, etc.), you must:

- avoid accessing to school and communicate absence from school for health reasons,
- return promptly to their home,
- promptly contact your doctor for the possible activation of the nasopharyngeal swab procedures.

In particular, during the period of school attendance, the school:

- undertakes to communicate any changes or additions to the provisions;
- makes use of adequately trained personnel on the organization of school services, in particular on health and hygiene procedures to prevent the spread of covid-19.
- The staff themselves undertake to scrupulously observe all health and hygiene protocols and to go to work only in the absence of any symptoms linked to Covid-19;
- undertakes to adopt all the health and hygiene protocols required by current legislation, including social distancing measures;
- undertakes to strictly and scrupulously implement any measures of the local health authority in the event of a clear Covid-19 infection of a child or adult attending the school.

## **b) DIGITAL LEARNING**

Distance learning will be activated in case of an increase COVID-19 cases, as stated in the Decree no.39 of 26/06/2020 - "School plan 2020-2021": paragraph "School plan for integrated digital education" *«Should the epidemiological trend suggest new emergency situations at a national or local level, the stop of in class-teaching and the use of digital learning could be arranged again, through the integrated digital teaching method.»*.

Distance learning requires a redefinition and strengthening of the educational pact of co-responsibility between schools and families.

### **The school is committed to**

- loan portable computers and carry out distance learning through applications also supported by mobile phones, since it is aware that not all families have the same technological devices and number of children of school age;
- reorganise the objectives of the annual planning and the evaluation criteria and communicate them through the website;
- make flexible didactic choices that take into account the different family and individual situations, especially in the case of pupils with special educational needs;
- work in a defined time slot, so as to help pupils and families to distinguish working time from family time;

- maintain communication with families individually through e-mails, the electronic register and the school website.

**The family is committed to**

- periodically consult the school website and the Electronic Register to view school communications;
- stimulate the pupil to participate in distance learning activities and to carry out the assigned tasks before the deadlines;
- ensure that the contents of the lessons, their eventual recordings and the online material that are posted for educational use are not used improperly or such as to cause embarrassment to the school and teachers;
- check that all current regulations for the defense of privacy are respected.

**The signing of this agreement commits the parties to respect it.**
